




- Only from Odoo version 14 there is an API available to make the integration.

Configuration in CRM application

The user must activate the developer mode first to create an API Key. To do so, go to **Settings** en click on '**Activate the developer mode**'



Then go to your own profile and select **Preferences**. (Behind the name of your own profile you will find the name of the database between brackets)



Then select **Account Security** and click on **NEW API KEY**.


It is very important that this description be clear and complete, it will be the only way to identify the key once created.

Configuration Bubble Software

Login as the user in the Bubble software. Go to CRM Connectors in the navigation bar on the left side, select the desired CRM integration by double clicking on it (please note that a CRM-application is activated if it has a blue frame around it).



Then fill in the **URL** you can find in the Navigation bar of the browser. Then fill in your **Username** (this is the username used for database access (may be different from the user's e-mail address in odoo itself) and the **API Key** and **Database name** you obtained from Odoo.
